AEG welcome the reduction in housing numbers of Addingham, as the least sustainable location in the sub-area, with high biodiversity, landscape and strategic green infrastructure assets, and closeness to countryside of national and international importance just beyond the district boundary. Reference the Addingham Neighbourhood Plan Landscape Assessment.							
We support small changes in the Green Belt boundary, to protect sites of high biodiversity, landscape, or green/blue infrastructure value within the settlement boundary, as long as land released from the Green Belt, is not itself of high biodiversity/landscape/green/blue corridor value and not in locations that reduce connectivity to the wider countryside.							
A substantial area in the north of Addingham Parish is in the protection zone for the North Pennines SPA/SAC, with fields providing nesting and foraging habitat which supports SPA/SAC protected birds. In section D. of the policy point 1, we consider there should be more clarity over the location of 'areas of importance' to the NP SPA/SAC.							
In point 4 we suggest that the 'national assets' beyond the district boundary should be specified							

In point 5, we strongly endorse recognition of Wharefedale's distinctive biodiversity, and in relation to the gateway role to the wider countryside we suggest that areas beyond the district boundary the Yorkshire Dales National



Park, and the Nidderdale AONB should be referenced.
