Tourism is a key economic factor for the area which needs to retain its character and biodiversity. On-going improvement is essential but it must not be at the expense of these factors.

Flood risk control is mentioned in paragraph 4.12.1 Point C. This is important in Wharfedale and is inextricably linked with the current stormwater / sewage infrastructure. This badly needs updating and whilst this is not the direct responsibility of Bradford it needs to “encourage” Yorkshire Water to address this as a matter of urgency.
